Term 2 Fees - Direct Deposit Payments

Just a reminder that your Term 2 Class Fees are now due and payable at reception or via direct deposit.

Most of you have taken advantage of our direct deposit option to pay your term fees. When you make payments using this option, please consider the following:

- You need to identify yourself to our computer system by quoting your unique Customer Reference Code in the payment description line of the actual bank transfer. We cannot allocate your payment to your account if we didn't know it was from you.
- This service is primarily designed to handle a payment in full of Term Class Fees. If you are making payments more often than once per term, a Frequency Fee of \$20.00 may apply. This also applies to payments made to costume funds, as each deposit made requires an extra reconciliation with our own computer system as well as that of the bank account.
- If you are using this service to make payment for items other than class fees (Registration Fees, Exam/Assessment Fees, Costume Fund, etc), you will need to email us with an itemisation for the actual payment. There is no need to make a separate transfer for each item as long as we know how the total transfer amount is to be allocated. All payments made by direct deposit will be assumed to be for term fees unless otherwise informed.

Thank you for using our direct deposit services. Your co-operation with these matters will enable us to continue offering this payment option.

DMADS & Ballet Exam/Assessments

All school-aged students are busy preparing for their dance assessments and examinations in their regular classes. These are to be held on the 27th June for Teen class levels, the 28th July for the Intermediate class levels, and the 29th June for Primary class levels. Payment deadline for the Jazz/Hip-Hop, Tap, & Modern Exam/Assessments & Classical Ballet Assessments is Monday, 1st June.
